Drop Off & Pick Up Area

As you may have noticed, the fence creating a safe corridor for students has been installed on the side of the Main building. Please take note of the following procedures for students who are dropped off in the morning (8:55-9:05) and picked up after school (3:45-3:55):

- Students and parents must wait on the sidewalk and on the front walkway in front of the Main building, NOT in the parking lot.
- A teacher will be on duty at the new FRONT gate, and not at the gate at the back of the corridor.
- The teacher on duty will open the gate to allow students to enter/exit at the designated times. Please do not attempt to open the gate yourself for safety reasons.

The waiting area for students and parents is designated as the sidewalk and walkway, just as it was previously on l'Assomption. It is important that parents continue to drive carefully in our school zone for everyone's safety. We have had less incidents of "near accidents" with fewer parents driving near the buses.

Parents are not permitted to park in the parking lot, as we have fewer spaces than staff members. Also, please do not let your child(ren) run or play in the parking lot before or after school, while staff are arriving and departing. Pedestrian circulation in the parking lot is not permitted, for obvious safety reasons. Playing on the snow hill in the parking lot is forbidden.
