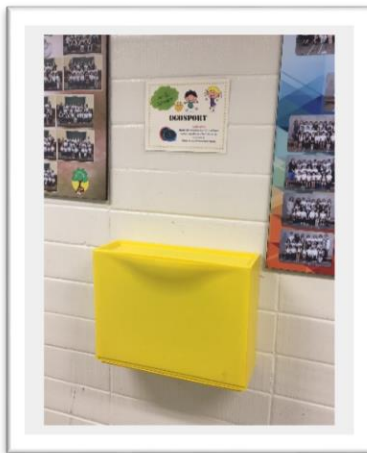

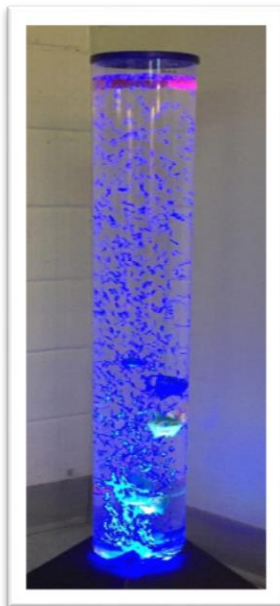
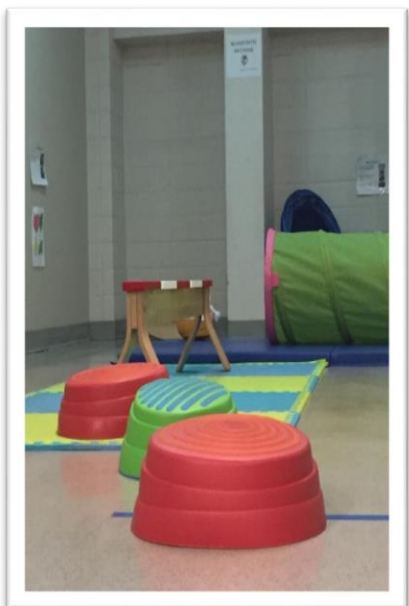
Classroom Brain Break Stations

Developed in 2106-2017 and implemented in August 2017, these break stations give students the opportunity to take a break from their work, expend some energy, and resume their work. This opportunity to “let it out” throughout the day helps students self-regulate, reducing their frustrations and incidences of verbal or physical aggression as an outlet.



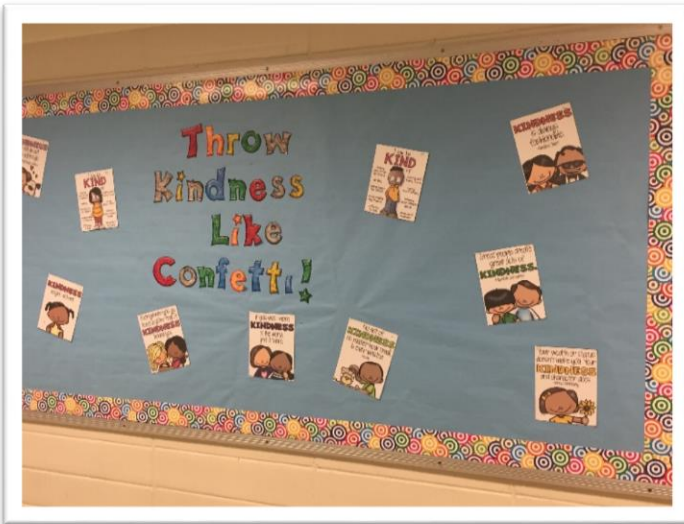
Sensory Room

We have built a sensory room, which is being used by 15+ students with ASD as well as some with ADHD and Sensory Processing Difficulties. Each identified student has an individualized circuit and attends the Sensory Room daily as part of his/her self-regulation goal
